CONSTITUTION

The purpose of the Society is to advance religion in accordance with the tenets, principles, observances and practices of the Unitarian Universalist faith by:

- a. Establishing and maintaining and operating a place of worship
- b. Preaching, teaching and manifesting the tenets, principles, observances and practices of the Unitarian faith through covenanting to affirm and promote:
 - i. The inherent worth and dignity of every person
 - ii. Justice, equity and compassion in human relations
 - iii. Acceptance of one another and encouragement to spiritual growth in our congregation
 - iv. A free and responsible search for truth and meaning
 - v. The right of conscience and the use of the democratic process within our congregations and society at large
 - vi. The goal of world community with peace, liberty and justice for all;
 - vii. Respect for the interdependent web of life of which we are all a part.
- c. Gifting to qualified donees as defined in sub-section 149.1(1) of the Income Tax Act of Canada
- d. Undertaking activities ancillary and incidental to the attainment of the above charitable purposes.
